- FRIA: Jason Baker gave an update on our application for FAA-Recognized Identification Area (FRIA)
 - The application for FRIA status has been submitted to the AMA.
 - AMA advised that it will likely be several months before we receive any response.
 - FRIA restrictions are not set to go into action until September 2023. Jason does not foresee any problems that might hinder eventual approval by the FAA.

- **New Business**

- Patches: Luther Hux secured for us a great deal on another batch of patches; all current members will be provided 3 patches.
- Bylaw Revisions: Lee Konopa presented revisions to the Bylaws that incorporated recent comments from club members. The package was reviewed and select changes made. Lee will now begin the formal process (see current Bylaws, Article 10) for final adoption of the revisions.

- Spring Work Day: The group scheduled a work day for field maintenance on April 8th, commencing at 9am.
- National Model Aviation Day: The group decided to prepare for an open house at the field on August 12th. Suggested events include:
