Unfinished Business

- Bylaw Revisions: The group voted to accept the most recently proposed revisions to the club bylaws. These updated bylaws will be posted to the club's website, and a copy will be submitted to the AMA.
- Entry Gate Reinforcement: Effort is ongoing; \$150 was previously authorized for reinforcement for the purchase of materials to make the repair.

New Business

- National Model Aviation Day, Open House on Aug 12th: Preparations continue. For safety reasons, only PCRC members will be allowed to fly at the open house.
- Club Picnic and Fun Fly on June 10th: Activities will commence at 11am. We will first hold the June general meeting, followed immediately by the picnic and fun fly.
- Painting of Chain Link Fence: A proposal was made to paint the top portion of the chain link fence with cans of spray paint. After discussion, we decided to table the proposal and to reconsider it along with any other proposed painting approaches at the next meeting.

- Business Cards: The group authorized the expenditure of up to \$100 for an order of 500 business cards for official use. The cards will have the current club design and will cite the club website for further information (i.e., cards will not include any individual's phone number or address.)
