Treasury Summary

Paul D. furnished to the membership detailed statements of our income and expenses for years 2022 and 2023. A high-level summary is:

Balance beginning of year:	2022 \$4,762	2 <u>023</u> \$3,235
Income during year: Expenses during year:	+2,070 - 3,597	+2,054 - 1,684
Balance end of year:	\$3,235	\$3,604

- The club has experienced a decline in membership during the past three years. To cover our operating expenses during this period, we have had to increase members' dues from \$40 to \$72.
- O To date, only 19 people have renewed their membership for 2024. At that level, our income for the year would be \$1,368. We would be able to afford only the bare minimum of services, i.e. pay our AMA obligation, operate and maintain the existing mowers, do one brush hogging, and service the portable toilet one time. (Dipping into the capital savings to cover routine operating expenses would provide only short run relief; it would not be tenable in the long run.)
- o Improving our long-term viability will likely require a combination of 1) expanding membership, 2) continuing our use of volunteer services where possible, and 3) setting dues at a level commensurate with other clubs.

Unfinished Business

- Flying Site Improvement Grant (FSIG): Jason B. is assembling the grant request for field maintenance/improvements. The deadline for submittal to the AMA is 1 February.
